(Blue panel at bottom) Always put on glasses when working with a grinder/whetstone.





 (Vertical text) But if your tools are faulty, the result will be the same.

(Page on Right)(Vertical text in red) For Safety
 (Page on Right) (Horizontal text in blue) Take wide turns at corners. Put flags at the tip of long objects. It only takes a single vocalization of notification--don't
 (Page on Left)
 (Bubble text on top) This way of connecting conveyor belts....
 (Text at bottom) You must be careful as well.

(Characters on top): Safety

(Characters in the middle, split into two circles): Danger

(Text at bottom): Turn the power off before touching or changing the belts of the machinery.

(Horizontal text on top): Disorder of materials and tools is the source for great disaster.
 (Vertical text): Disorderly stowage will tumble with the smallest of vibrations.

(Vertical text on right): To put on safety goggles
 (Vertical text on left): Or to lose your vision.

(Vertical text in the middle of the poster): It is important to pay attention to methods of stowage.
 (Top right hand corner): Do not allow it to protrude out to passageways.
 (Bottom right): Pay attention to your footing.
 (Top left hand corner): Do not block emergency exits and access.
 (Bottom left): Do not heap too high.

(Right half of the poster): As monkeys fall from trees
 (Left half of the poster): Skilled workers may also, from being off-guard,...
 (Based on the proverb, "Monkeys also fall off from trees," which means that even the most skilled or experienced may, at times, fail or in this case, get injured.)

It's dangerous to chat while operating machinery!

Stop littering rags and scraps. Designate a container for safety first!

 (Vertical text in red): This one hand can be the source of a debacle.

 (Vertical text on left): Coming home late from work!
 (Text on top, in white): Injury, Hospitalized.

 (Text on right): For machinery, there are safety devices.
 (Characters depicted in motors): The foundation of acceleration
 (Text on left): For the body, there are protective apparel.

(Text, on lower right hand corner): Defective tools are the source of injury.

(Horizontal text, on top): You can't see with an artificial eye
(Diagonal text): Protect your eyes!
(Text at bottom): It is imperative to wear protective/safety glasses/goggles.

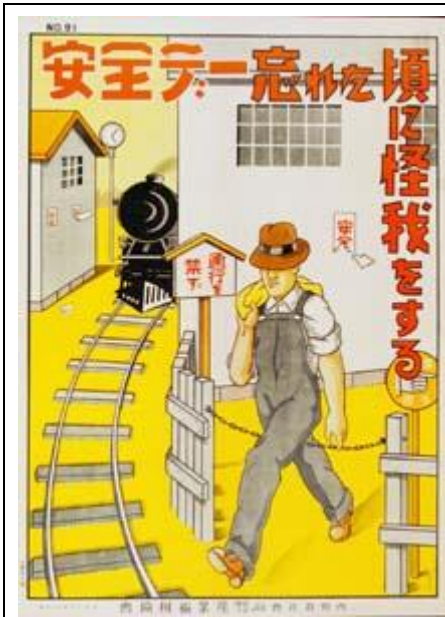
(Vertical text on far right, in blue): Do not neglect organizing and cleaning up pathways.
(Vertical text on right, in black): Inattention and daydreaming are the source for great injury.
(Vertical text on left, in blue and white): Danger!
(Vertical text on far left, in white): Watch your footing

(Vertical text, in red): Taking matters into your own hands is the source of injury.
(Vertical text, in white): Amateurs, do not attempt steam and electronic repairs on your own. Ask the person in charge to fix it for you.

(Text, from top left hand corner): Safety Day--
Injuries come around when you start forgetting about it.

(From top): Cleanliness, Organization, Beware of Fire.

(Horizontal text): Long sleeves, long apron string
(Vertical text): Are the source for injury

(Horizontal text in black, and vertical text in red): Be careful not to run, slip and fall.
(Text at bottom, in black): Spilled oil or water should be wiped up immediately.

(Vertical text, in yellow, on top): Consider the machinery and tools as part of yourself.
(Horizontal text at bottom): Always make an inspection prior to usage, and take good care of them.

(Horizontal text on top): Determine a storage space for inflammable chemicals.
(Vertical text, in white): The source for fires.

(Horizontal text, on top, in white): When checking for gas leaks,
 (Horizontal text, at bottom, in red): use soap water.
 (Circular text, towards the top): It is dangerous to check with a match! Explosion!

(Horizontal text in blue to vertical text in white): Trolleys and cars--watch out for each other.
 (Horizontal text in black): Don't forget to signal at intersections, and proceed slowly. Even if you're in a hurry, yield for a second with a smile.
